This schedule is attached to and a part of these Standards for the above identified occupation.

1. TERM OF APPRENTICESHIP

The term of the occupation shall be 2 years with an OJL attainment of 4,000 hours supplemented by the required hours of related instruction.

2. RATIO OF APPRENTICES TO JOURNEYWORKERS

Consistent with proper supervision, training, safety, and continuity of employment throughout the apprenticeship, the ratio of apprentices to journeyworkers will be 2 apprentices to 1 journeyworker.

3. APPRENTICE WAGE SCHEDULE

Apprentices shall be paid a progressively increasing schedule of wages during their apprenticeship based on the acquisition of increased skill and competence on the job and in related instruction, as follows:
